





SCOTT SNYDER AND GREG CAPULLO TAKE THE STAGE FOR DARK NIGHTS: DEATH METAL

Interview by Albert Ching

Dark Nights: Metal stands as one of the biggest DC events of the past decade, with writer Scott Snyder and artist Greg Capullo channeling the energy of their seminal Batman run into an event series that sent heavy metal thunder reverberating across the DC Universe.

In May, Snyder and Capullo reteam for *Dark Nights: Death Metal*, a sequel to the 2017-2018 event that aims to turn the volume up to 11, positioning DC's heroes in extremely hostile territory—and tying together the last several years of stories from across DC's publishing line into a bigger, louder, and unexpected encore.

Back when Dark Nights: Metal was first announced, you both talked a lot about the fun of it. What's the tone of Death Metal–in what ways is it similar, and in what ways is this one different for you?

Greg Capullo: One thing that's going to be similar: There will be Joker dragons. They're making an encore!

[We're] going bigger and louder. [The first script] is so jam-packed, dense with exciting and great metal-esque comics stuff, that I think everyone is going to lose their mind when they get to this.

Scott Snyder: We consider *Metal* an opening act for the real show, which would be this one. As crazy as [the original] was, it was pretty contained. Now we've had a lot of threads running through different things, between *Justice League, Justice League Dark, Batman/Superman*, some things in *The Flash*...we've had a lot of power batteries hooked up at once.

This time we really want to blow the story out through the whole DCU in an even bigger and crazier way. If there were five evil Batmen in the first one, then there are hundreds in this one. If there was a Joker dragon in the first one, then they're just commonplace in the sky in this one. It's that: characters you don't expect to see, characters people are hungering to see Greg draw. It's definitely upping the ante from the first one.

Other than being a natural—and awesome—title for a sequel, what can you tease about what "Death Metal" means in this story?

Snyder: It doesn't have to do with mowing down all the superheroes or killing tons of people, but it has to do with a secret beneath Death Valley. There is a "death metal" itself-that's in the story-and there's a reason it's called that, and there's a history to it, that ties into a lot of things that we were building both with the JSA, and other characters from the past.

But also–it just sounds cool, man. There's no turning back. The stakes are higher. Everyone's life is on the line.

The very first image released for this was Wonder Woman with a very intriguing "Chainsaw of Truth." What can you say about the role she plays? Is she a lead character?

Capullo: Definitely, which is exciting for me. I was initially intimidated by Wonder Woman. When Scott gave me this, and she's got such a

prominent, up-front role, I was excited. It's no longer intimidation—I'm now excited to portray her as I feel I understand her to be.

Snyder: She's the perfect person for the story. When the story starts, the heroes are in a really bad position. We start in a place that's going to really shock you, and it's a place where the only way out is to discover the truth about not only what happened, but the kinds of terrible things the villains have done over the years—and the truth about what we've done in other stories; in *Event Leviathan*, in *Doomsday Clock*, and all of that. Wonder Woman is the perfect character to go after the truth, whether it's a lasso, or better yet, a chainsaw.

The cover also has, notably, Superman with a Darkseid arm and a grim reaper-esque Batman with a scythe. What can you share about that at this point?

Capullo: Other than to say it looks freaking awesome?

Snyder: Without giving too much away, things have happened in the world that have forced them into roles that are desperate. So the heroes, without changing who they are, without becoming less hopeful or becoming darker themselves, find themselves in a world that's darkened significantly around them. It's really about the heroes being crazy beacons of hope-rock gods of heroism in this world that's so dark and hellish at that moment. They inspire us to always reach higher.

They look crazy: Wonder Woman with a chainsaw and a "queen of hell" look. Batman with a grim reaper sort of look. Superman looking like he's becoming apocalyptic–actual Apokolips, Darkseid Apokolips. It looks like they're dark, but it's not. It's actually them being ultra-heroic in a world that's become pretty nightmarish.

Let's talk about the villains—things have been building in a big way with Perpetua in Justice League, and presumably the Batman Who Laughs is looming as well?

Capullo: If you noticed, his skull is strapped on Wonder Woman's belt as a trophy–that's a bit of a giveaway that one way or another he's making an appearance.

I just got done reading this script, and I've got a lot more evil characters to create. Lots more villains coming.

Snyder: The Batman Who Laughs has had a really specific role in the DCU, and we've seen him a lot, so if he's going to be in this event, he's going to play a different role, and he's going to surprise you. We're very careful about not repeating ourselves ever. It's going to be wildly different, and what happens with him will be unexpected, I promise you that.

Our goal this time is not to do something that exists in a vacuum, but to make something that rewards you for your reading and make everything matter. All these stories exist in one universe–let's do one giant rock party that makes the entire saga of the DCU come together.



BATMAN: THE ADVENTURES CONTINUE TEAM TALKS NEW STORIES, NEW CHARACTERS

Interview by Albert Ching

Batman: The Adventures Continue is exactly what it sounds like: a return to the world of Batman: The Animated Series, with all-new comic book stories starring the Dark Knight and his familiar allies and villains, plus characters from the wider DC Universe introduced to the beloved animated world for the first time.

This new, digital-first series is co-written by Paul Dini and Alan Burnett, both producers of the original animated series, and illustrated by Ty Templeton, who has brought the world of B:TAS to comic books since 1992's Batman Adventures #1. All three discuss returning to Batman's animated world and what new additions to expect.

When does Batman: The Adventures Continue take place, relative to the last time we saw these versions of the characters? Has time passed, or does it pick up pretty much where things left off?

Paul Dini: It's pretty much a continuation. Fans familiar with the Batman of *The New Batman/Superman Adventures* will be right up to speed. Alan and I approached the writing with the idea that we were doing the season you might have seen if we had not put the series aside to do *Batman Beyond*.

Alan Burnett: What is different, however, is that we're going back to cover certain gaps in the original series, events that didn't have a bearing on the series at the time, but now do. In other words, there will be secret histories that will turn Batman's world upside down. Things that no one knew were out there, until now.

Ty Templeton: Tim Drake is still a very young Robin, Batman isn't middleaged or anything, and we're not even close to the events of *Batman Beyond*.

Deathstroke makes his debut here in the Batman: The Animated Series world. How much fun is it to get to play with that character, in this context?

Templeton: Deathstroke is one of DC's enduring hero/villains. I've always loved his design and his history with the Titans, which makes him part of Dick Grayson's history, which makes him part of the Bat-world. Slade is kind of a "Batman but with guns" type of character, only with a very different moral code. That kind of tension, where characters have different approaches to similar problems, is always a fun undercurrent to play with.

Dini: Deathstroke is a challenge because he's been such a big part of the current DC animated world. We had to forget the versions of Slade Wilson that have existed before in *Teen Titans* and other places, and reinvent him as someone who has never met Batman, Robin, and the others before.

That said, it was fun to come up with a first encounter between him and Batman and rework his character and motivations in a way that made sense of the animated series at that time. We've also given him

someone new to interact with, a female protégée named Sunny. Yes, her name is ironic. She's sort of a Batgirl gone way wrong.

Any other new/surprising additions you're able to tease?

Burnett: You are going to see quite a few of the villains we used in the old *Batman* series, some making just bit appearances, but there will be a definite sense of that animated world. We even allude to certain episodes, such as one in which Robin befriended a little lost girl who turned out to be part of Clayface. She comes back for a page or two in these comics.

But perhaps the most intriguing character in the run will be young man whose story threads through most of the issues. He's a smart, super-elusive loner who knows way too much about the Dark Knight. How this mystery man fits into the world of *Batman Adventures* and what he means to accomplish should, I hope, be a real jolt for old fans.

Dini: We're bringing in Azrael and showing how a version of him could fit into this world. A number of old favorite adversaries are coming back: Clayface, the Mad Hatter, Roxy Rocket—and that's just in issue #2! There are plenty more surprises down the road.

There is so much fan love for this series—how meaningful is it to you to see how much Batman: The Animated Series and its associated titles have endured?

Burnett: Of course I think it's wonderful how it's endured. But I think the reason it has is because we all loved Batman back on the animated series and took the best from the comic books. We really respected all the creators who went before us, and fans knew that. So now here we are 25 years later getting back into it again, and we've been having a terrific time from page one. How great is that?

Templeton: There's never been so accessible, so accurate, so "right" a version of Batman on film as those original episodes and movies. It's been an honor to help this talented team bring some level of that world onto the page at DC.
