Joe Hill, the horror mastermind behind NOS4A2 and Locke & Key has arrived at DC to curate his own pop-up line of cutting-edge horror comics! Starting in October, Hill House Comics will terrify readers with a smart, subversive and scary lineup of five original series that continue DC's history of horror from HOUSE OF SECRETS to THE SANDMAN and beyond!

"At Hill House Comics we aim to shock the senses and soak the page in red, with new, hooky horror from seasoned old hands and young masters of the field, all set free to share their most disturbing nightmares...for your pleasure! The books are backed by DC's second-to-none comic book craftsmanship, and we're working with the very best editors on parole from Arkham Asylum to craft unputdownable tales of menace and madness," Hill said. "I can't wait to share some fresh scares with comic book readers everywhere. It's going to be fun."

Hill House Comics debuts on October 30 with BASKETFUL OF HEADS #1, written by Hill and illustrated by Leomacs. The chills continue in the following months with THE LOW, LOW WOODS, THE DOLLHOUSE FAMILY, DAPHNE BYRNE and PLUNGE, spotlighting the work of some of the biggest names in horror storytelling.

Plus, every issue of each Hill House Comics series will include the serialized backup story "Sea Dogs," written by Hill and chronicling three werewolves terrorizing a crew of sailors at sea.

JOE HILL TALKS HILL HOUSE COMICS AND *BASKETFUL OF HEADS*

Joe, what makes BASKETFUL OF HEADS the right series to kick off Hill House Comics and set the tone for the line?

I've had the idea for BASKETFUL OF HEADS kicking around in the back of my mind for almost a decade. I even took a pass at the first script in 2011 or thereabouts, but it needed more time to brew. My subconscious stayed busy with it, apparently-the first four issues practically wrote themselves.

I wanted our first title to be insane, WTF, relentless reading: to script something that would blast along like an 18-wheeler going downhill with no brakes. These days, there's so much entertainment out there, there's so much distraction-if you want to cut through the noise, you've got to come out with guns blazing. You have to do your best to deliver something that'll keep the reader flying through the pages.

What can you share about the main character, June Branch, and how she navigates the truly unconventional situation she finds herself in?

If writing BASKETFUL OF HEADS has been a lot of fun, it's probably because I so like spending time with June. She's

bright and sunny and open-someone we can love, someone we can root for-who also happens to be as flexible and sharp as a fencing blade. Her beloved, Liam Ellsworth, is snatched away by a gang of desperate men, for reasons she doesn't understand. She finds herself pursuing them with an eerie, occult axe and her own unique understanding of human nature. I won't say which I think is the more valuable asset.

Leomacs may not be familiar to a lot of DC fans-what's it like working with him bringing this story to life?

I'm so lucky to be working with this guy. Leomacs gets that even though this is a dark, suspenseful story, we're also setting out to have some good, gory, stomach-turning fun. He brings an anarchic, subversive energy to every panel. It's everything I was hoping for, and then some. I really wanted to tell a tale that was tense, funny, and unrepentantly grotesque-think of films like Re-Animator and Evil Dead 2. Tense, funny and unrepentantly grotesque is Leomacs'

sweet spot.

Let's talk "Sea Dogs": the phrase "patriotic werewolves" is certainly intriguing. What makes the Revolutionary War and lycanthropy a good match?

Well of course there's one big connection between "Sea Dogs" and BAS-KETFUL OF HEA-oops, forgot I wasn't going to talk about that stuff.

I read a lot of historical fiction and have had an urge to dip my toe into the genre for a long time. I also have sort of intense feelings about Hal Foster's Prince Valiant and love the idea of a backup feature in Hill House Comics that operates along some of the same lines. It's like a big, old-fashioned Sun-

The other thing about "Sea Dogs" is that I've always sort of had a yen to write the story of the Demeter, the ship in Dracula that carried the count from Transylvania to England. By the time it reached English waters, everyone on board had been sucked dry-he slaughtered the entire crew. But weirdly, it all happens off-screen. The most thrilling part of the whole novel is only hinted at. How weird is that? "Sea Dogs" is a chance to explore a similar sort of narrative, but on a big canvas,







KAMI GARCIA DEFINES "CRIMINAL SANITY"

JOKER/HARLEY: CRIMINAL SANITY is unlike any tale of this duo you've read before, so we talked to Kami Garcia to learn more on what she has planned for these two iconic characters.

The Joker/Harley Quinn dynamic occupies a uniquely beloved place in pop culture. What are you looking to explore about their relationship in the story? How will this series surprise fans of the characters?

Harley and The Joker are two of my all-time favorite characters in comics and pop culture. Harley is a fighter and a survivor, and I didn't want to lose those aspects of her character. But I was interested in reframing their relationship.

She's a brilliant psychiatrist and, like real psychiatrists, she has been trained to identify the manipulative tactics of sociopaths and psychopaths. So I wanted to write the version of Harley who would never fall for The Joker's manipulation. In fact, from a forensic psych standpoint, our Joker would become obsessed with her (psychopaths are incapable of love). You'll have to read the series to see how that plays out.

What can you share about working with the book's two artists—Mike Mayhew and Mico Suayan—and how they split the visual narrative of the series?

Mico and Mike are both incredibly talented. Mico has been attached to the project for almost a year. I stumbled on his work for *Werewolf By Night* and *Bloodshot*, and I knew he would be the perfect artist for the gritty present-day sections of the narrative featuring Harley as a profiler, consulting on visually arresting crime scenes. And, of course, he lends that rough edge to The Joker.

Mike's work on Mary Jane and Star Wars immediately hooked me. We needed someone for the sections of the narrative that tell the story of Joker's evolution as a psychopathic killer, which means the artist had to be exceptional at drawing children and teenagers, as well as adults.

The detail in Mike's work and his ability to capture nuanced emotions in a single expression is perfect. Mike is also drawing some of the present-day narrative.

Following TEEN TITANS: RAVEN, what's it been like changing gears for CRIMINAL SANITY-and writing a serialized comics series rather than a graphic novel?

Switching from young adult subject matter to something much darker and more adult isn't hard for me. But going from writing a graphic novel to serialized comics is a challenge. Writing serialized comics is such an art. My editors, Molly Mahan and Kristy Quinn, are amazing. I was also lucky enough to get advice from Brian Michael Bendis and Tom King early on.


It's clear this is a much more grounded take on The Joker and Harley than seen before, touching on the real world of criminal profiling and forensic psychology. What kind of research helped shape this story?

I've always been fascinated with origin stories–following the breadcrumbs someone left behind to figure out how their past shaped the person they are now. If the breadcrumbs were left by a serial killer, the question for me becomes: How does a person become a monster? And no monster is more interesting than The Joker.

This isn't the first time I've written about serial killers, so I've done a lot of research over the years...but the level of authenticity in CRIMI-NAL SANITY is way above my pay grade. My friend, Dr. Edward Kurz, MD, has consulted on the project with me for two years. We talk daily. Ed is a forensic psychiatrist and behavior analyst (profiler), who was personally trained by the late Roy Hazelwood, co-founder of VICAP, the FBI's program to profile serial killers, and an original member of FBI's Behavioral Science Unit (BSU). He trained under, and worked for, Dr. Fred Berlin, Jeffrey Dahmer's defense psychiatrist. He is also a consultant to domestic and international law enforcement. Ed's input has been invaluable in making sure this story is as true to life as possible.

JEFF LEMIRE FLASHES HIS "KILLER SMILE"



THE JOKER: KILLER SMILE is an all-new and truly terrifying look at The Joker. We talked with writer Jeff Lemire about why he wanted to take on the Clown Prince of Crime and reteam with GREEN ARROW collaborator Andrea Sorrentino.

Given the stature of the character, there has to be some intimidation that comes with telling a Joker story. What aspects of The Joker did you want to explore? What shaped your take on him?

I've written a lot on the DC Universe in the past, but I have never really had a chance to write any of the Batman related characters, so this opportunity was very exciting for me. Aside from Batman himself, of course, Joker is probably the most iconic character in that corner of DC. But I didn't really feel intimidated by it, really just excited to try and do something new and fresh and put our own spin on the character, while still celebrating all the great Joker stories that have come before.

In terms of what Joker stories I looked to for inspiration, it really came down to three specific books. Of course KILLING JOKE is the greatest and most iconic Joker story, and its influence cannot be ignored. But I also reread Brian Azzarello and Lee Bermejo's JOKER and the Steve Englehart and Marshall Rogers run in DETECTIVE COMICS.

It's exciting to see you reteaming with Andrea Sorrentino for this story—what made him the right collaborator for KILLER SMILE?

Andrea and I have developed a really great chemistry since our first project together, which was our run on GREEN ARROW for DC. Since then we've continued to grow and experiment as a creative team, both at Marvel and currently with our creator-owned series, Gideon Falls.

The aspect of Joker that interested me the most was his influence on other people: how his madness can spread and infect and reshape the world around him. Andrea is the perfect artist to take that concept and bend the visual reality of the book to express it in new and exciting ways.


Let's talk about the other major character in the story, Dr. Ben Arnell-how is he so (clearly misguidedly) confident he can diagnose The Joker?

Ben is a great guy. Nothing wrong with good ol' Ben Arnell. He'll be totally fine, I promise. Chances are good Ben will succeed in treating Joker's madness, and the story will have a very happy ending for all. Really.

Or...Dr. Ben Arnell could be the reader's gateway into terror and insanity, and a whole world of mayhem like nothing Gotham City has ever seen.

Do other familiar DC characters beyond The Joker play a part in KILLER SMILE?



PHILLIP KENNEDY JOHNSON INTRODUCES THE LAST GOD

In THE LAST GOD, Phillip Kennedy Johnson, Riccardo Federici, and Dean White have created a vast high fantasy world from the ground up—and infused it with "all-in horror." We talked with Johnson about the deep world-building of THE LAST GOD, and bringing the worlds of fantasy, horror, and comics together.

It's a conspicuous time for high fantasy in pop culture—what does it mean to you to bring the genre to DC with THE LAST GOD?

The opportunity to bring high fantasy to DC Comics is a huge honor, and one I don't take lightly. I know plenty of people who love Game of Thrones, Stranger Things, World of Warcraft, Magic: The Gathering, but who might not see themselves as fans of comics, at least not of superhero stories people immediately associate with comics. THE LAST GOD is my chance to bring new fans into the comics community, and maybe even introduce some hardcore comics fans to high fantasy.

You've described LAST GOD as equal parts horror and fantasy. What is it about horror and fantasy that works so well together?

The fantasy genre is an insane playground with no rules...you can ride a crazy idea as far as your imagination will take you, which makes it perfect for horror. But despite that, truly all-in horror/high fantasy mash-ups are rare, and I don't think I'm the only one who wants one. In every fantasy series I ever read, the scary parts were always the most fun, and I always wanted to see more. I want an alternate future of Westeros where an aging Kingslayer leads a mismatched team of psychos into a frozen King's Landing to assassinate the Night King, Cersei the Night Queen, and his own White Walker child, the undead Prince of Westeros. These are the kinds of stories we're telling in THE LAST GOD.

The visuals for this are stunning – what's it been like collaborating with Riccardo Federici and Dean White in bringing Cain Annun to life?

If DC gave me free rein to choose any penciller and any colorist in the world for THE LAST GOD, I would have chosen Riccardo Federici and Dean White. Riccardo has perfect instincts for both fantasy and horror, and his imagination and technique are unparalleled. Meanwhile, Dean has a surgeon's understanding of anatomy, and everything he colors has this incredible hand-painted look to it. Every book I've read with either Riccardo or Dean on the team has been elevated by their involvement. Having them together on the same book makes me want to elevate my own work, to help the team make a book that readers remember for years to come.

People are already excited about exploring the LAST GOD lore even further—how much will backmatter like maps play into the overall package?

We want readers to dive as deep as they want into the lore of Cain Anuun, to the point that gamers will be able to create their own campaigns in Cain Anuun. Every single issue will include pages of backmatter at the end, specifically for lorehounds like myself. If you finish the latest issue, and wonder why this one Eldritch Knight's armor was different from everyone else's, or you want to know more about that creepy Northern religion that got mentioned, or wish you could read Aelvan musical notation...you'll find material in the back that explores all of that and much more.

For even more on the world of Cain Anuun, we have a printed sourcebook coming out after the first arc. We've already recorded in-world music that we'll be sharing online periodically, complete with sheet music for people who want to play or sing it themselves. I've never read a comic that took worldbuilding as far as we are on this series...if that's something you're interested in, do not miss THE LAST GOD.
