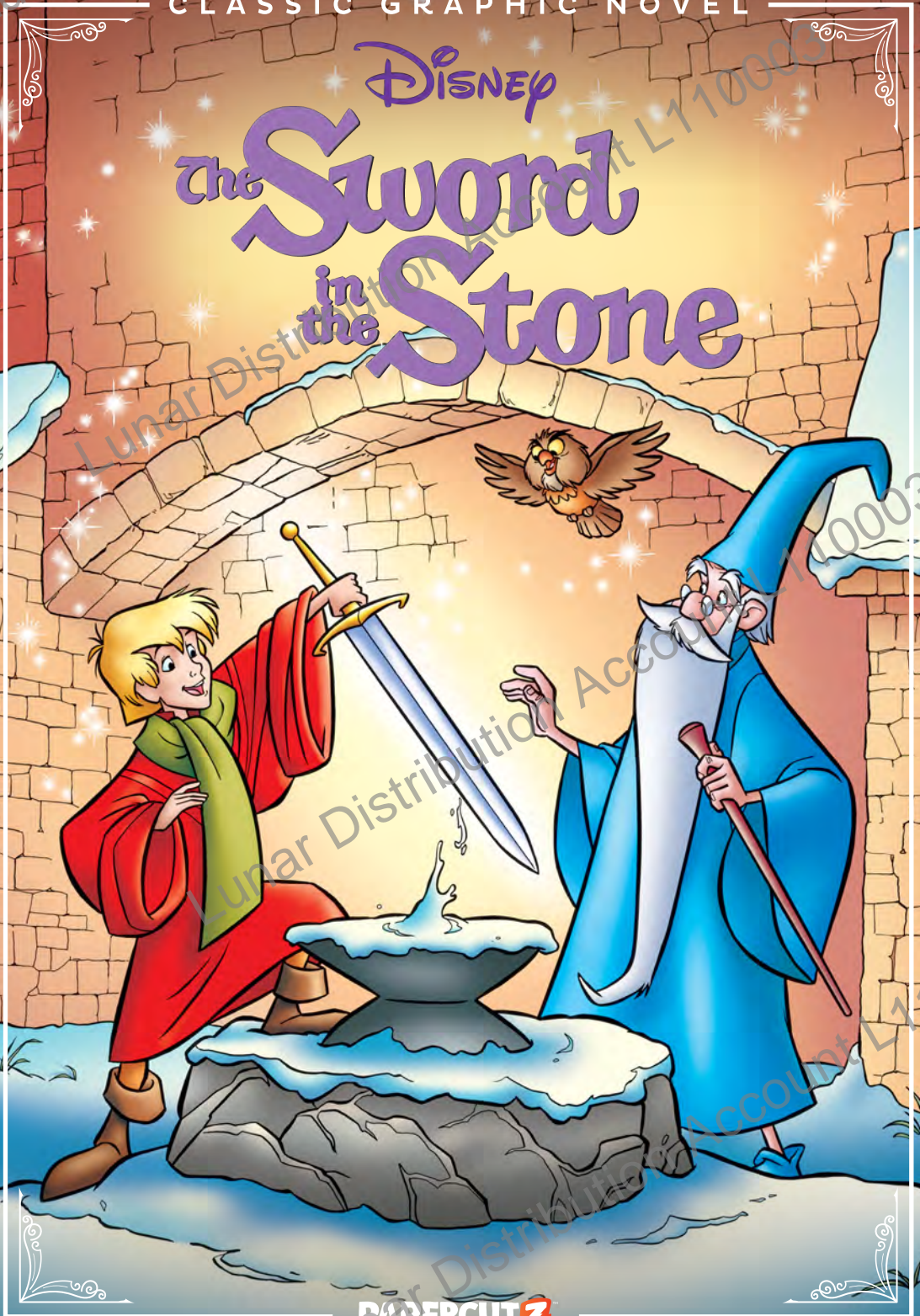

in an anvil.

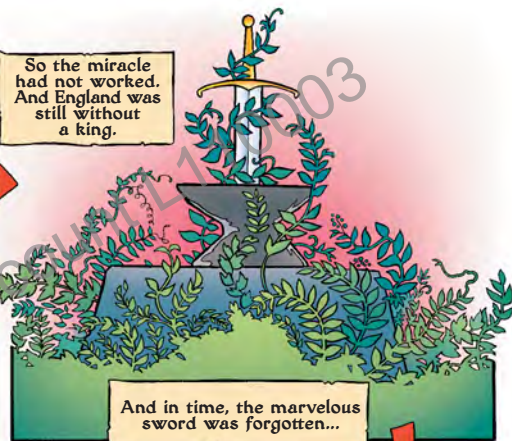
And below the hilt,

Though many tried for the sword with all their strength, none could move the sword, nor stir it.



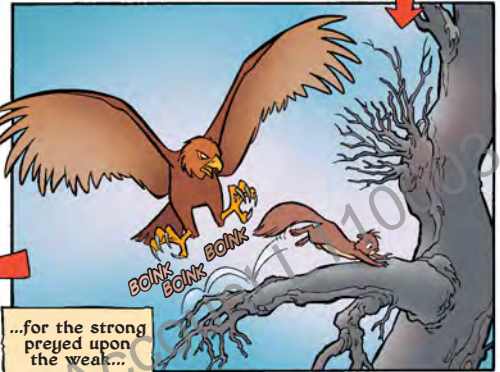
So the miracle had not worked. And England was still without a king.

...for the strong preyed upon the weak...



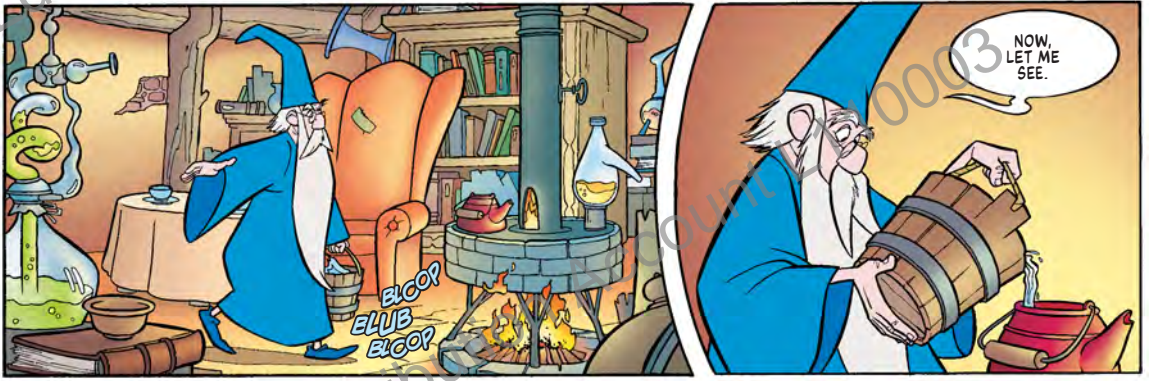
A DARK AGE INDEED! AGE OF INCONVENIENCE!

I TOLD YOU, ARCHIMEPES. I AM NOT SURE.



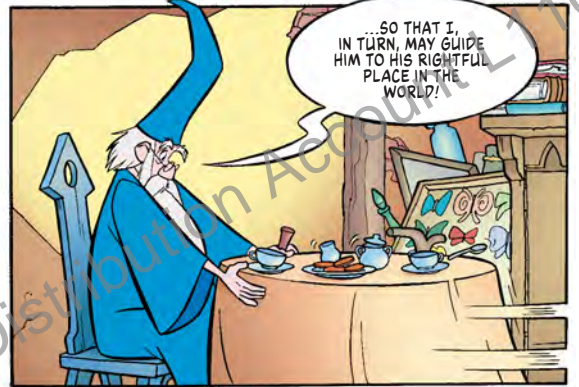
ALL I KNOW IS THAT SOMEONE WILL BE COMING.
